

Education for Natural Disaster Preparedness (ENDP) in the Context of ESD

Goal:

To contribute to the reduction of vulnerabilities, the loss of human lives, and economic and environmental damages caused by disasters through the power of knowledge and education for natural disaster preparedness.



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Project approach

In line with the Hyogo Framework for Action, which promotes "the integration of disaster risk reduction as an intrinsic element of the UN Decade of Education for Sustainable Development", ESD will be employed as a framework to facilitate and enhance holistic consideration of interrelations between society, the economy, the environment and culture

Regional Workshop on Education for Disaster Risk Reduction for Sustainable Development – UNESCO/ISDR/UNICEF joint initiative

October 2007, Bangkok, Thailand (tentative)

 Convene curriculum developers, practitioners and policy makers from throughout the Asia-Pacific region to develop a regional strategy promoting ENDP as a top priority of governments' political and development agendas.



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Regional workshop Objectives

- Seek political commitment for integrating disaster risk reduction within school curricula
- Promote non-formal education activities
- Highlight the role and contribution of local communities in the educational process
- Increase the recognition of indigenous/traditional knowledge
- Identify good practices in ENDP and regional "champions"
