Regional/Oblast emergency	50-100	500-1,000	10,000-50,000 Times minimum salary	Within the boundaries of one region
National/Republican Emergency	100-500	>1,000	500,000-1,000,000 Times minimum salary	2 adjuscent regions or 3 districts of Republican subordination
Boundary Emergency			-	Neighboring states as well as Tajikistan


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















