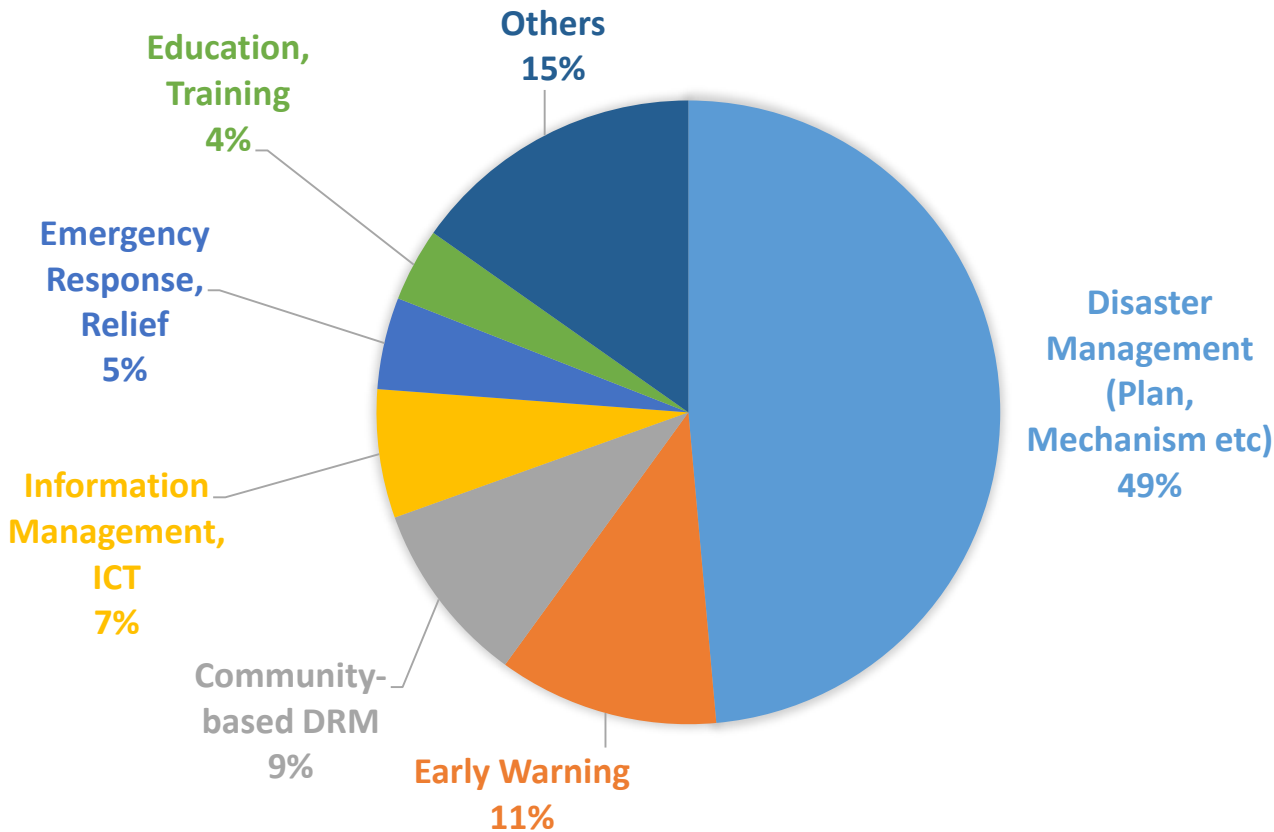
- Term A: August-November Term B: January-April

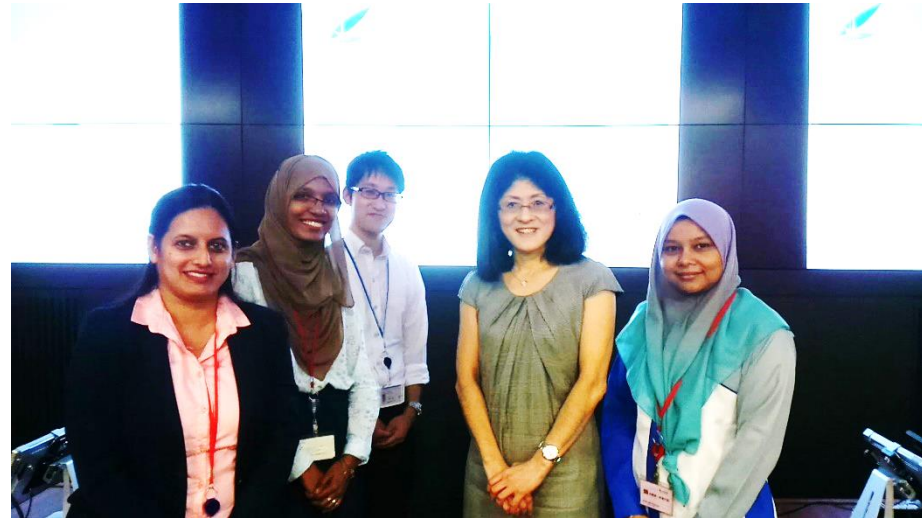
