2-3-5 ADRC Highlights

ADRC has been using the Internet and e-mail to share information with its counterparts in member countries, and with other interested parties. As one of its mainstay tools for information dissemination, ADRC has been issuing the twice-a-monthly newsletter "ADRC Highlights" since June 1, 1999. This newsletter is made publicly available on the Web. It is also e-mailed in English and Japanese to ADRC's counterparts, participants in past ADRC expert meetings, ADRC personnel at home and abroad, visitors to ADRC, and participants in international conferences ADRC have taken part in.

The subscriber mailing list of the newsletter dramatically expanded by 580 persons between the end of March 2003 and the end of March 2004 – from 380 domestic and 1,050 overseas readers to 470 and 1,540, respectively – a 40% year-on-year increase.

The contents has included articles on the latest ADRC activities, reports of events, such as international conferences, which ADRC staff attended and gave presentations in, as well as national reports by ADRC visiting researchers from member countries. At international conferences and other events, ADRC staff have frequently been asked questions related to the contents of the newsletter. ADRC often receives responses to the newsletter immediately after it is e-mailed. Thus, the newsletter is considered an effective tool for information sharing.

In awareness of the newsletter's effectiveness for information sharing, and of the fact that Russian is more convenient than English in some of the member countries including Russia a Federation and NIS countries, ADRC started to web-publish and e-mail the Russian version of the newsletter in 2002. As of the end of March 2004, the number of subscribers to the Russian version totaled 70 persons. The number is expected to increase as more disaster management training programs are implemented for Central Asian and the Caucasus.
