5-1-2. JICA Training in Turkey

1) Basic Concept

Turkey experienced a serious damage from the 1999 Marmara Earthquake, which took more than 17,000 lives. Since the local seismic activities still threatened to wreak similar damages in future, Japan International Cooperation Association (JICA) organized a disaster training seminar on disaster management for disaster managers in Turkey in order to enhance the country's disaster management capabilities. The distinction of this seminar is that it consisted of two modules, the Japan module and the local module: Turkish specialists were trained and taught in the Japan module about Japan's advanced disaster prevention technologies prior to the local module where they were to deliver lectures to the seminar audience consisting mainly of vice governors and county mayors. This approach allows a seminar configuration with more weight placed on the local module so that a large attendance can be accepted to get a maximum effect out of a short period of time. At the request from JICA, ADRC conducted a local investigation to plan the seminar programs and dispatched a group of lectures for the local module of the seminar.

2) Preliminary Local Investigation

(1) Purpose

The purpose was two-fold: to grasp the current state of Turkey's disaster reduction policy through investigative hearings at the country's disaster reduction authorities (Ministry of Internal Affairs, Ministry of Public Works and Housing, Crisis Management Bureau of the Prime Minister's Office, universities, etc.), and to enrich the contents of the programs of the local module of the seminar by introducing successful cases of Japan's disaster prevention measures.

3) Local Module of the Seminar

(1) Purpose

In Turkey, vice governors and county mayors are in charge of local disaster control administration. The local module of the seminar was intended to train them and enhance the overall capabilities as Turkish disaster control administrators. This module was jointly held by the Ministry of Internal Affairs of Turkey and JICA.

(2) Periods

First round: Sep. 29 – Oct. 3, 2003 Second round: Oct. 6 – Oct. 10, 2003 Third round: Mar. 8 – Mar. 12, 2004 Fourth round: Mar. 15 – Mar. 19, 2004

(3) Seminar Contents

The seminar consisted of four one-week rounds taught mainly by the lecturers who attended the Japan module. From Japan, Mr. Satoru Nishikawa, ADRC's executive director, Assistant Prof. Kimio Meguro of Tokyo University, and Prof. Kazuki Nakabayashi of Tokyo Metropolitan University participated as short term expert lecturer and delivered speeches on Japanese disaster prevention systems. Table 5-1- \bigcirc shows the program schedule of the first round of the seminar. The contents of the second to the fourth rounds were almost the same.

In the post-seminar questionnaire, the participants gave quite high rating scores to the Japanese lecturers, and many of them found the contents of the lecturers as relevant and informative.
